Abstract. During field studies two interesting species were recorded for the first time from Bulgaria, namely *Pluteus aurantiorugosus* (on chestnut wood in Belasitsa Mt near the border with Greece) and *Suillus lakei*, an alien species, associated with *Pseudotsuga menziesii* in the western part of Stara Planina Mts. Another unrecorded in this country bolete, *Boletus cisalpinus*, was recognized on previously misidentified specimen from the Bulgarian Black Sea coast. Descriptions of both species are provided upon the Bulgarian samples.
