

Torrejón, M. 2009. Contribution to the study of hypogeous fungi of Castellón, Spain. III. — *Mycologia Balcanica* **6**: 61–65.

Abstract. Fourteen species of hypogeous fungi have been collected and studied in the province of Castellón in Spain. Significant diagnostic characters are given for some of them. Several species that belong to the *Basidiomycota* are of special interest: *Alpova microsporus*, *Hymenogastser bulliardii*, *H. hessei*, *H. luteus*, *H. lycoperdineus*, *H. muticus*, *H. niveus* and *Protoglossum aromaticum* (= *Hymenogaster remyi*).
